WCRA represents ~90% of the waste and recycling industry across NSW and the ACT. There are several issues of significance impacting the industry at present, including changes in Chain of Responsibility regulations, changes in insurance risk protocols and changes in global recovered resource markets – potentially exposing the industry to added risk and uncertainty. WCRA is working with its Members to better understand and manage potential impacts that these changes may bring.
