

WCRA LIFE MEMBERSHIP NOMINATION GUIDELINES

Approved at the WCRA Executive Meeting 12 May 2015

WCRA Rules

- "Life Members" means persons who have been appointed by the Executive as Life Members of the Association for outstanding service for a minimum of 10 years to the Industry and the Association provided that a person appointed by the Executive as a Life Member of the Association will cease to be a Life Member if the appointment is disallowed at the next General Meeting of the Association by the Members (WCRA Rule 5 j)
- Will be entitled to attend and speak at all meetings of the Association (WCRA Rule 6.1 b)

Guidelines for the Executive

- Must have through his/her involvement with WCRA enhanced the operation and reputation of the Association & the industry.
- Must have consistently put the interests of the Association and the industry ahead of his/her personal and business interests in the discharge of his/her WCRA duties and responsibilities.
- Must never have brought the Association or the industry into disrepute.

Benefits to WCRA and the Life Member

- Will be publicly recognised as a Life Member of WCRA (a page will be set-up on the WCRA website that acknowledges each Life Member)
- Will be invited to selected, key WCRA functions (free of charge)
- On a case-by-case basis and with the permission of the Life Member, WCRA may nominate the Life Member to assist an appointed representative of the Association to address an issue of importance.
