## Clarification received from the Roads & Traffic Authority

## Wearing of seat belts by Waste & Recycling Truck Drivers

6<sup>th</sup> July, 2009

Sub-rule 264 (2) of the *Road Rules 2008* states that:

The driver must wear the seatbelt properly adjusted and fastened unless the driver is:

- (a) reversing the vehicle, or
- (b) exempt from wearing a seatbelt under rule 267.

Sub-rule 267 (2) of the Road Rules 2008 states that:

A person in or on a motor vehicle is exempt from wearing a seatbelt if:

- (a) the person is engaged in the door-to-door delivery or collection of goods, <u>or in the</u> <u>collection of waste or garbage</u>, and is required to get in or out of the vehicle, or on or off the vehicle, at frequent intervals, and
- (b) the vehicle is not travelling over 25 kilometres per hour.

According to the rules above, a driver of a vehicle collecting waste or garbage is not required to wear a seat belt, if the driver is required to get in or out of the vehicle at frequent intervals and the vehicle is not travelling over 25 kilometres per hour.
